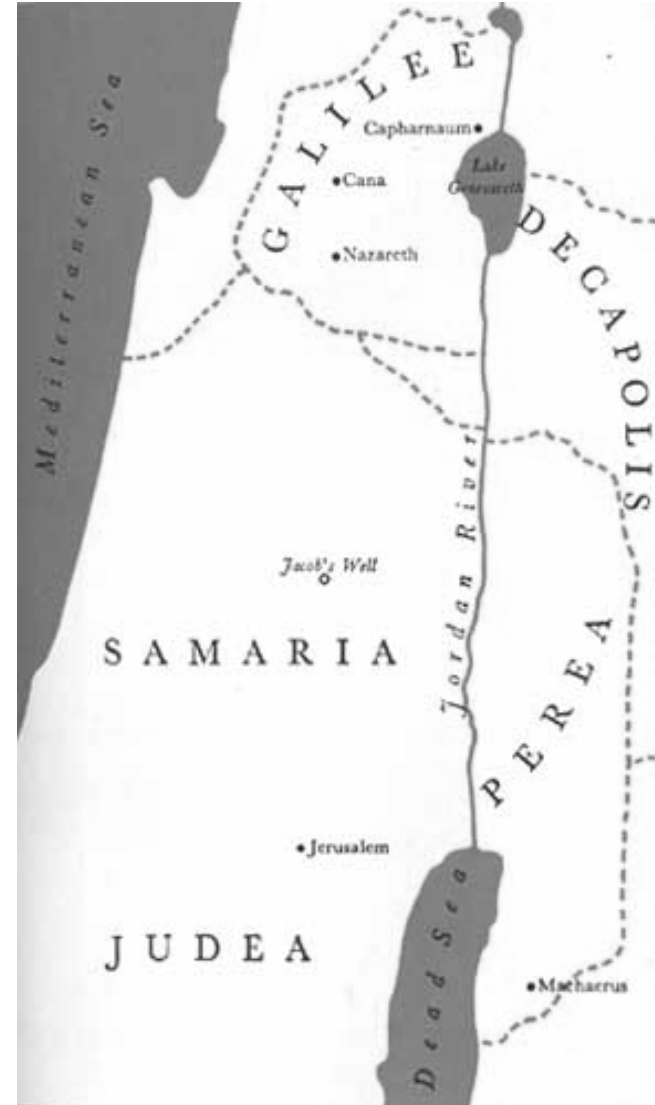

In John 4:1-42, Jesus models the ideal approach of presenting the gospel of salvation to a lost sinner.

- I. The effective evangelist harbors no racial bigotry, but instead proclaims the nature of salvation (4:1-14).

- II. The effective evangelist has no moral discrimination, but instead identifies the nature of the human condition (4:15-19).



III. The effective evangelist has no religious pride, but instead extols the nature of God (4:20-24).

V. The effective evangelists trusts in God's sovereignty and the power of His Word in the hearts of sinners (4:39-42).

IV. The effective evangelist has no social prejudice, but Instead explains the nature of Christ's role (4:25-38).
